Glossary of Terms

Item No.	Term	Definition
1.	LTCP	The Long Term Control Plan (LTCP) is the document that lays out how DELCORA will maintain the outfalls and reduce the flow and/or treat the discharge from the outfalls to the waterways to meet the requirements of the Clean Water Act.
2.	Sanitary Sewer	The system that contains only waste from bathrooms, sinks, washers, etc.
3.	Storm Sewer	Run off from streets
4.	Combined Sewer System	Pipe that has both sanitary sewage and storm water in it
5.	Combined Sewer Overflow	An overflow is the relief point in the combined sewer system that allows the extra flow when it rains to be discharged directly to streams and rivers
6.	USEPA	United States Environmental Protection Agency
7.	PADEP	Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection
