Re: Long Term Control Plan Approval

Dear Mr. Willert:

On July 1, 2025, Delaware County Regional Water Quality Control Authority (DELCORA) submitted a revised Long Term Control Plan (LTCP) as required by the Consent Decree in *United States and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection v. Delaware County Regional Water Quality Control Authority*, Civil Action No. 2:15-cv-4652, E.D. Pa.

The Environmental Protection Agency Region 3 (EPA or the Agency), in consultation with the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP), provided comments to DELCORA on the submitted documents and a revised version of the LTCP was submitted by DELCORA on December 11, 2025.

Paragraph 34 of the Consent Decree identifies the methods by which EPA may approve or disapprove a submission, which includes (a) approve the submittal, in whole or in part; (b) disapprove the submittal, in whole or in part; (c) approve the submittal upon specified conditions, directing DELCORA to modify its submission; or (d) any combination of the above.

Based on the Agency's review of the LTCP, and associated supporting documentation, the LTCP submitted on December 11, 2025, and attached herein, is hereby considered approved as of the date of this letter.
